Drawing Hands and Feet



Weekend Workshop

Hands and Feet are arguably the most difficult elements of the human anatomy. A large amount of information is contained in very small volumes, and those forms appear very differently depending pronation, supination, extension, flexion, and separation of digits, as well as the viewer's own perspective. Hands and hand gestures can be even more expressive than faces and therefore so much of the success of a figure rides on properly rendered and constructed hands. Feet will root the figure and can convey as much as hands to the success of a pose.

The workshop will begin with a slide lecture, followed by exercises in the construction of hands and feet. We will use an easy sculpting medium to physically build a model of a hand and one of a foot, in their most basic planar forms. To ground our understanding of construction, we will focus on constructive drawing of hands and feet in different positions, and end with rendered drawings from master copies.

Students will be given a wealth of resources for further work on their own, past the time limit of the workshop.
