Copying from the Masters is a key component of Academic Art training. It is by far the fastest route to understanding how to render the human form, how to handle the formal elements of shape, value and edges.

By copying what a Master has done, we learn experientially how to put Classical principles into play, in order that our own work might benefit from internalizing these time-honoured techniques.

This weekend is intended for those with some experience in drawing the human figure, and who wish to take their work to the next level. We will be working in charcoal and chalk, and will be working from Pierre Paul Prud'Hon and Mariano Fortuny drawings.
