Drawing/Painting Drapery

Weekend Workshop

Drawings of draperies found in old Masters' work is alluring, enticing and awe-inspiring, yet depicting drapery is one of those mysteries, whose answer eludes all those who approach the topic without the fundamentals of Classical principles of light logic.

In this weekend workshop we will examine the basic 7 kinds of folds that are identified and categorised by Bridgman, and which lend movement, dynamism or static elements to figurative and still life work. Using a combination of slideshows, drawing or painting from the masters and from life will be covered in the 10 hours we have together.

We will learn experientially how to put Classical principles of light and understanding of form into play. Very importantly, we will learn to understand what we are seeing, and how to convey form with a separation of the form into light and shadow pattern. Within the lights, we will turn the form to convey roundness or angular corners. In the shadows we will identify and represent form shadows, reflected light, cast shadows and occlusion shadows.

Each student will take away completed studies of examples of each kind of fold, and will take annotated notes in their sketchbook for future reference that will inform their own work.

Students will have a choice of mediums to work with: graphite, charcoal, chalk, or paint.
